The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) has updated the Remedial Action Permit (RAP) applications/forms and instructions based on the updates made to the Soil RAP Guidance document. Significant changes/additions to the RAP applications/forms include the following:

- a revised soil contaminant data table with the new Soil Remediation Standard designations on the Soil RAP Initial and Modification Applications;
- a new question on the Soil Remediation Standards for the Migration to Ground Water exposure pathway on the Soil RAP Initial Application; and
- change of the "Primary Responsibility for Permit Compliance" language in Sections D and E of all RAP Applications/forms to "Primary Contact for Permit Compliance."
