In order for licensed site remediation professionals (LSRPs) to more easily meet the continuing education requirements for license renewal, the Site Remediation Professional Licensing Board ("SRPL Board") is implementing a new policy on Continuing Education which will restrict the definition of "Alternative Verifiable Learning Format" ("AVLF") to only those programs that are offered in a format that does not permit real-time interaction with presenters. This will allow more programs to be considered "in-person," even if attendance is remote and synchronous.
