Contaminated Site Remediation & Redevelopment (CSRR) is pleased to announce the availability of the instructions for the Prioritized Initial RAP Application Addendum.

These instructions will assist the LSRP in determining if a site is eligible for Prioritized Application Addendum submission and how to complete the addendum form. These instructions were reviewed by the RAP stakeholder group and address frequently asked questions.
