The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) Contaminated Site Remediation & Redevelopment (CSRR) posted phase-in guidance for Initial Ground Water Remedial Action Permit (RAP) Applications that include contaminants where the Ground Water Remediation Standard (GWRS) changed by an Order of Magnitude (OOM), based on the Ground Water Quality Standards (GWQS) adopted on February 3, 2025.
