Subject Updated Receptor Evaluation Form and Instructions

Contaminated Site Remediation & Redevelopment has updated the Receptor Evaluation Form and Instructions. Significant revisions are listed below. Please see the change log for a full list of changes.

- Section E has been revised to clarify that potable and irrigation wells (permitted and unpermitted) must be identified within the required distances referenced in the New Jersey Technical Requirements for Site Remediation.
- Instructions were added to Section C which was revised to provide clarification on the types of documents which could be required to be submitted with a receptor evaluation.
- Hyperlinks relevant citations and guidance documents were updated.
- The following statement was added to Section G: "*Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26E-4.8, the Ecological Risk Assessment is required to be conducted during the RI phase of the remediation and must be completed within the RI Regulatory Timeframe.*"
