# Greatly Reduced Case Backlog

- Pre-SRRA case count (May 2009)  $\approx$  20,000
- SRP current case count = 13,805
- Total Cases Closed = 19,864
- Goal achieved for 2014 - Closed Out More Cases than We Got In

(as of June 30, 2015)





# LSRAP Program: Increasing Rate of Cleanup and Readying Sites for Redevelopment

- RAOs 2011 = 762
- RAOs 2014 = 1,742
- RAOs to date = 7,396
  
- Cases Closed 2011 = 433
- Cases Closed 2014 = 1,295
- Cases Closed to Date = 3,854





# Remedial Action Permits

- 2010 = 69 permits issued
- 2014 = 653 permits issued
- Total to date = 2,011 permits issued
- Issuing permits for sub slab depressurization systems.





# **Priority Initiative:** **Focus Resources on IECs**

- Staff freed up to support IEC identification and response
- IEC staff bolstered to address 513 IECs currently identified (297 using public funds, 216 by responsible parties)
- Receptor Survey Team / Receptor Evaluation Requirements
- IECs now identified sooner and more proactively
  - Last 5 Years = 271 IECs identified
  - Prior 5 years = 135 IECs identified
- USIs find the source of the IEC





# Upcoming Initiatives and Ongoing Stakeholder Process

- DEP Online
  - Fees, LSRP Retention/Release
  - RI Report (NEW)
  - Remaining Remedial Phase Reports – coming!
- 20 Technical Guidance Documents finalized
  - 7 more in development





# Stakeholder Process Remediation Standards

- Technical Guidance on the Alternative Remediation Standards for the Ingestion-Dermal and Inhalation Exposure Pathways, as well as the EPH Protocol.





## Changes in SRP

- The Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste Management is being moved into the Site Remediation program, to form a new Site Remediation and Waste Management program office under the leadership of Assistant Commissioner Mark Pedersen.

- Natural and Historic Resources – Rich Boornazian, Assistant Commissioner

- Compliance and Enforcement – Ray Bukowski, Assistant Commissioner
