In 2009, Nauna's Bella Casa in Montclair was the first New Jersey business to install public charging stations for electric vehicles. In 2015, they expanded their commitment by installing the first public fast charge station in the state. Fast charge stations can recharge a typical electric car to 80% in about 30 minutes. Learn More

Terhune Orchards in Princeton uses several strategies to reduce its transportation footprint. Terhune purchased two five-passenger pickup trucks for farm workers, **nine electric carts** to travel around the property and **a plug-in electric cars**. Learn More
