McCaffrey's of Princeton composts or donates the majority of the food waste generated in the market. All food waste generated by the perishable food departments including fruits, vegetables and proteins is collected and sent to an organics' composting business. Over a year, McCaffrey's reduces its food waste by 44,220 lbs. and saves \$1,540.

Berje Inc, a flavor and fragrance manufacturer generates about 100 Scrap Pallets/7,500 Lbs. of wood per week. They offer all scrap pallets at no cost to a number of trucking companies. The pallets are reused as pallets and any minor damages are repaired. Berje used to have to pay for the disposal of the damaged pallets which could fill a dumpster each month.
