Encourage the use of reusable water bottles

Install low-flow fixtures and aerators in bathrooms

Install rain barrels and rain water catchment systems

Upgrade to touchless sensor faucets

Check for leaks and make repairs immediately

Upgrade to water efficient commercial and industrial equipment



The **Carroll Villa Hotel**, located in the heart of Cape May's Historic District, installed low flow shower heads in its guest rooms to reduce water usage. Annually, this retrofit saves over 20,000 gallons of water and reduces its water bills by over \$500. [Learn More!](#)
