

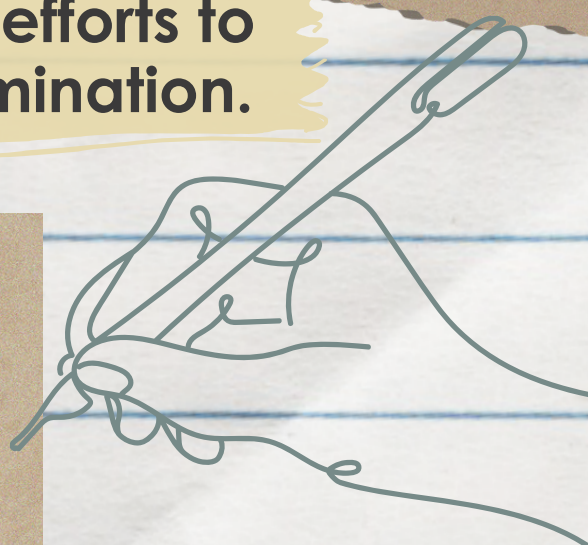
Recycle Right NJ

THE GOAL

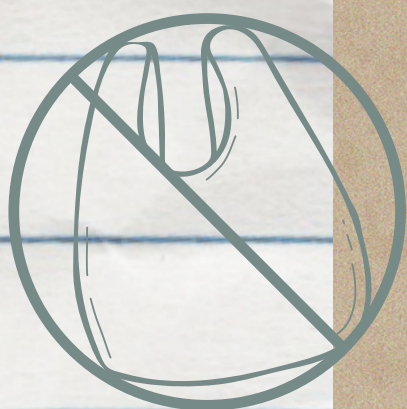
Keep millions of tons of material from being disposed in the trash each year by recycling while providing manufacturers with needed materials to make new products with recycled content.

THE PROBLEM

“Recycling contamination” is anything that finds its way into a recycling bucket, bin or cart that does not belong there. Some examples are plastic bags, plastic syringes, auto parts, garden hoses, bowling balls, Styrofoam cups, and trash.

THE EFFECT

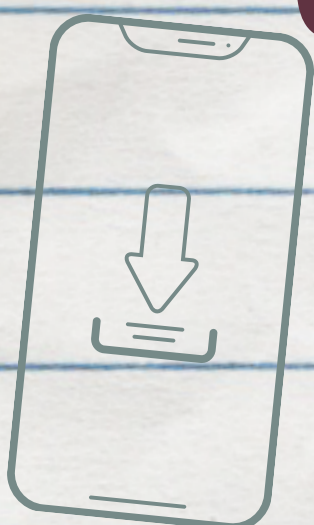
Recycling contamination creates serious quality control issues, poses a health and safety threat to recycling center workers, and negatively affects the economics of recycling.
