Dredging Requirements within 200 feet of a dam

Unless otherwise approved in writing by the Bureau of Dam Safety (Bureau), no person shall dredge within 200 feet of a dam unless the following requirements are met:

- 1. A current inspection report should be on file with the Bureau.
- 2. A New Jersey licensed professional engineer experienced in the design and construction of dams must certify that dredging within 200 feet of the dam will not compromise its safety.
- 3. An engineering plan with appropriate specifications prepared by a New Jersey licensed professional engineer is to be submitted outlining the limit of disturbance, cross sections showing depths of dredging, and sequence of construction.
