

Please be advised that permit applications normally submitted on paper via regular mail may now be submitted via electronic mail to: luasu@dep.nj.gov

This option is for the following application types, only:

- Applications utilizing the “Permit Application Form” (aka “LURP form”)
- Applicability Determinations
- CAFRA Individual Permit and Upland Waterfront Development extension requests
- Dredging Sampling and Analysis Plans
- Acceptable Use Determinations
- Applications involving conservation easements (releases, modifications, etc.)

NOTE: The luasu@dep.nj.gov email option may not be used for those applications which must be submitted via the NJDEP Business Portal [NJDEP | DEP Online | DEP Online-Business Portal](#), in accordance with applicable regulations.

Please remember to include the following information as separate attachments to your email:

- Completed LURP, JD, Dredging, etc., form
- Application contents as per the appropriate checklist
- Copy of the signed check if applicable

Following submission of the email, mail the paper check (if applicable) with a cover letter indicating that the check is associated with an application submitted via the luasu email. Also include the county, municipality, block and lot for the project location. The check must be made payable to “Treasurer, State of NJ”, and mailed to:
