AMENDMENT TO THE ATLANTIC COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on DEC 03 1993 , pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Atlantic County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment, submitted on behalf of the Mullica Township Board of Education, allows a new wastewater treatment plant to be built discharging to subsurface sewage disposal beds. This amendment is a result of a State mandated upgrade to the current substandard building conditions at the existing Elwood School. addition onto the existing Elwood School allows the building to better serve as an elementary and middle school. addition increases the building space by 15,867 square feet. The functional capacity of the new Elwood Elementary/Middle School will be 911 students with an anticipated wastewater flow of 13,665 gallons per day.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues will be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which were not reviewed in conjunction with this amendment but which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic

River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulations under federal or State statutes or rules.
