REVISION TO THE LOWER DELAWARE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on June 5, 2001, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Lower Delaware Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision was requested on behalf of Friends Home, an age restricted residential community to be located on Block 36, Lot 17.01 & 17.02 in Pilesgrove Township, Salem County. The revision modifies the Woodstown Sewerage Authority (WSA) Wastewater Management Plan with regard to this site. The facility is an expansion of the future sewer service area to contiguous lots, the expansion involves less than 100 acres, contributes less than 8,000 gallons per day of additional wastewater flow, and does not create a significantly new pattern of sewered development such that a significant potential or incentive is created for additional revisions or amendments to open new areas to sewered development. The revision transfers 7,990 gallons per day of future allocated residential wastewater for the Borough of Woodstown to future allocated residential wastewater for the Township of Pilesgrove. Additionally, this revision includes a minor mapping change to include this parcel in the future sewer service area of the WSA facility. Due to the scope of this revision, it is not subject to the alternatives analyses required by Executive Order 109 (2000).
