AMENDMENT TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY WATER QUALITY
MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on September 7, 2006, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Monmouth County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This amendment, submitted on behalf of the Millstone Township School District, allows for an on-site discharge to groundwater wastewater treatment facility to serve the Millstone Township Middle School to be located on Block 25, Lot 1. The 114.5 acre lot is located in Millstone Township, Monmouth County. The Middle School's total population will be 850 persons, including both staff and students. The onsite discharge to groundwater disposal system will accommodate 16,850 gallons per day (gpd) of wastewater flow projected in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:9A-7.4 based on the planned number of staff and students.

This amendment proposal was noticed in the New Jersey Register on July 3rd 2006, at 38 N.J.R. 2890(b) and no comments were received during the comment period.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues may need to be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: compliance with stormwater regulations; antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River

areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.
