REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Take Notice that pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Management Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning Rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Raritan Water Quality Management Plan (WOMP) has been adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This revision notes in the Township of Roxbury Wastewater Management Plan (WMP), the existing Gemini Industries, New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) permitted discharge to groundwater (NJ0077587), which is located in Roxbury Township. This facility consists of a 230,000 sq. ft. building and proposes an expansion resulting in a total of 597,000 sq. ft. of which 48,000 sq. ft. will be office space and 399,000 sq. ft. will be warehouse and manufacturing. The facility currently employs 128 persons and proposes to expand to a maximum of 556 employees (185 office employees and 371 warehouse/manufacturing employees). There shall be no shower facilities available and no food preparation at the facility. Vending machines will be the only food service provided on site. The subsurface disposal system is for sanitary wastewater only. The facility has a sanitary wastewater design flow of 11,565 GPD. The wastewater is directed to an on-site wastewater treatment and discharge to ground water disposal system. This qualifies as a revision under N.J.A.C 7:15-3.5 (b)1.
