REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on MAR 2 9 2010 , pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This revision updates the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) and the Parsippany Troy-Hills Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) to identify the existing Croatian Cultural Club discharge to ground water which serves the Croatian Cultural Club site that is located on Block 1, Lot 6, in Montville Township, Morris County, New Jersey. This revision also updates the digital sewer service area mapping adopted on October 6, 2006 to identify the service area of this existing discharge to ground water. The currently unpermitted facility has a total projected wastewater flow of 2,625 gallons per day. The wastewater flow is based on "club" as the establishment with 240 persons at 10 gallons per day and "boarding house" for 3 guests at 75 gallons per day.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b)1, the Department has determined that the proposed project qualifies as a revision to correct, clarify, or update erroneous, unclear, or outdated statements in an areawide WQMP, since the existing facility was never identified in the Parsippany Troy-Hills Township WMP. Therefore, the service area of the existing facility's discharge to groundwater is identified in the Northeast WQMP/Parsippany Troy-Hills Township WMP and the digital wastewater service area mapping. This mapping correction is authorized as a revision pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b)1.
