REVISION TO THE OCEAN COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT **PLAN**

OCT 1 9 2015 TAKE NOTICE that on , pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision (Program Interest No.: 435448; Activity No.: REV150002) to the Ocean County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision also modifies the Monmouth County Future Wastewater Service Area (FWSA) Map. The revision addresses the existing townhouses in the currently existing Sunnyside at Howell subdivision on Block 129, Lot 85.01 in Howell Township, Monmouth County. This residential portion of this subdivision is currently connected to the Manasquan River Regional Sewerage Authority (MRRSA) which conveys to the Ocean County Utilities Authority Northern Water Pollution Control Facility (NJ0028142) sewage treatment plant located in Brick Township, Ocean County. The entire subdivision was located in the sewer service area delineated in the MRRSA Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) adopted on May 3, 1993, but the eastern half was inadvertently omitted from the sewer service area when the Monmouth County FWSA map was adopted in 2013. The Sunnyside at Howell subdivision received Preliminary and Final Site Plan and Minor Subdivision Approval from Howell Township Planning Board on November 12, 2009, sewer extension approval from MRRSA on September 15, 2010 and a Treatment Works Approval from the Department on February 10, 2011. No new construction or flows are proposed beyond what that which was previously approved for sewer service in the above referenced approvals. Two commercial buildings are proposed for Lot 88.03 as part of the original subdivision approval. Lot 88.03 was in the previously adopted MRRSA service area and remained in the sewer service area when the FWSA map was adopted. As such Lot 88.03 is not the subject of this revision. This revision is being adopted in accordance with N.J.A.C.7:15-3.5(b)1, which allows revisions in order to correct, clarify, or update erroneous, unclear, or outdated statements in an areawide WQMP.
