




AMENDMENT TO THE SUSSEX COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on **MAY 24 1993**, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Sussex County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment adopts the Wantage Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). The WMP delineates the ground water discharge areas for facilities with a design capacity of less than 2,000 gallons per day (gpd), the ground water discharge areas for facilities with a design capacity of less than 20,000 gpd (wastewater flows not to exceed 390 gal/acre/day), and the service areas of the Regency at Sussex and High Point High School existing sewage treatment plants (STPs). The WMP also identifies the following three proposed STPs for wastewater generated from any water treatment process: STP for Borough of Sussex water treatment facility, STP for Simmons Water Company, and the STP for Baldwin Well Drilling Company. The WMP also identifies the existing STP at the Department of Corrections High Point Annandale Unit.
