AMENDMENT TO THE SUSSEX COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN Public Notice

Take notice that on JUN 30 1993 , pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Sussex County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment, proposed by Sussex Borough and the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority (SCMUA), updates the Sussex Borough Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). The amended Sussex Borough WMP allows for decommissioning the existing Sussex Borough sewage treatment plant with conveyance of Sussex Borough wastewater flows to the SCMUA Upper Wallkill Valley Water Pollution Control Plant (SCMUA plant) in Hardyston Township, Sussex County. This amendment to the Sussex Borough WMP will also amend the Hardyston Township WMP to specify that the SCMUA plant will be expanded from 2.5 million gallons per day (mgd) to 3.0 mgd to address the flow from Sussex Borough.
