REVISION TO THE SUSSEX COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on No. 2.0 2014, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq., the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15, and P.L. 2011, c.203 as modified by P.L. 2013, c.188, a revision to the Sussex County Water Quality Management (WQM) Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision, submitted on behalf of Mr. Stephen Shaw, Managing Member, of Route 15 Properties, LLC, creates a new discharge to groundwater sewer service area (SSA) for a proposed gas station with 16 filling stations, a 21 seat restaurant, a building consisting of 22,476 square feet of retail space and a warehouse with 160 employees located in Jefferson Township, Morris County on Block 273.01 Lot 11 and Block 273.02, Lots 1 & 2. The proposed projected flow volume to be discharged on site from the proposed development, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C 7:9A, is to be 7,945 gallons per day (gpd).

Adoption of this revision was conditioned upon demonstration of compliance with the submittal of the following additional information: a digital GIS shapefile of the proposed discharged to groundwater SSA, updated text and facility table, in this case for discharge to groundwater of up to 7,945 gpd, to be included in the pending Jefferson Township Municipal Chapter of the Morris County Wastewater Management Plan and final decision of the Sussex County Board of Chosen Freeholders as the Designated Water Quality Management Planning Agency for this WQMP area. As the aforementioned materials were received and met Department approval the conditions for adoption of this revision are hereby satisfied.
