



AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on December 7, 1987 pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the "Water Quality Management Planning and Implementation Process" Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment will expand the sewer service area of the Gloucester County Utilities Authority to include the proposed "Holiday City at Monroe" residential development. The amendment will also allow the filling of 1.79 acres of wetlands for 3 road crossings and 5 drainage easements. Approval of this amendment is conditioned on the completion of compensatory mitigation as approved in the wetlands mitigation report, including the creation and restoration of 1.6 acres of wetlands and the preservation of 2.75 acres of uplands. All remaining wetlands on the project site have been identified as a wetlands conservation easement.
