AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on April 6, 1988 pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the "Water Quality Management Planning and Implementation Process" Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment approved the Mount Laurel Township Utilities Authority Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). The WMP allows the expansion of the existing Hartford Road Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) from 2.95 million gallons per day to 6.0 MGD. The WMP also calls for the abandonment of the existing Rancocas Woods, Ramblewood, and New Jersey Turnpike Service Area treatment facilities. The wastewater currently treated at these facilities will be conveyed to the Hartford Road STP for treatment. The WMP will also expand the sewer service area in Mount Laurel Township.
