



AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on January 24, 1990, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment adopts the Camden County Municipal Utilities Authority (CCMUA) Atlantic Basin Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) and also amends the Mullica River Basin portion of the existing Winslow Township WMP. The Atlantic Basin WMP proposes the expansion of CCMUA's sewer service area to include all of Chesilhurst Borough. In addition, the WMP proposes the transfer of 1.2 million gallons of wastewater out of the Mullica River Basin (from Winslow Township, Waterford Township, and Chesilhurst Borough) to be treated at the CCMUA Delaware #1 wastewater treatment facility. This WMP does not supersede the service areas delineated for the Berlin Borough and Berlin Township WMP adopted August 20, 1986.
