Amendment Being Proposed (Include location within the WQM Plan(s) of the changes):

This amendment adopts a Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) for Harmony Township, Warren County. The WMP identifies two proposed sewage treatment plants (STPs), the Brainards/Buckhorn Creek and Harmony Station STPs, which will discharge to the Delaware River and the Lopatcong Creek STP which will utilize groundwater discharge. An area along Route 519 in the northern portion of the Township is designated as an on-site groundwater disposal facility area. The remainder of the Township will utilize individual subsurface sewage disposal facilities.
