

REVISION TO THE UPPER DELAWARE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on SEP 14 2004, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Delaware Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the Township of Greenwich and the Town of Phillipsburg Wastewater Management Plans to add the existing Quaker City Motor Parts/NAPA mini-mall in Greenwich Township on Block 24, Lot 3.01 (approximately 4.1 acres) to the Township of Greenwich sewer service area that is served by the Town of Phillipsburg Sewage Treatment Plant, in accordance with a Judicial Consent Order that was filed with the Superior Court of New Jersey on March 19, 2004. The existing mini-mall has a failed on-site septic system that will be abandoned upon connection of the mini-mall (projected wastewater flow of 3840 gallons per day) to the public sewer system.
