TAKE NOTICE that on **JUL 2 0 2009** pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et <u>seq</u>, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Delaware Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision grants the Township of Blairstown, Warren County, with alternative assignment of wastewater management plan (WMP) responsibility. In a letter dated June 30, 2008, the Warren County Board of Chosen Freeholders notified the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection that the County does not intend to submit a WMP. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.13(c), the Township of Blairstown has requested WMP responsibility for the Township.
