REVISION TO THE UPPER DELAWARE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et <u>seq</u>, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Delaware Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) and the Borough of Alpha Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision recognizes the existing surface water discharge for Alpha Borough-Well #3 located on Block 36, Lot 15.01 on Frace Road in Alpha Borough, Warren County. The discharge is not currently identified in the Borough of Alpha WMP, but has been in existence for over 15 years. Pending NJPDES permit number NJG0133965 identifies a discharge of 45,000 gallons lasting one hour and occurring once every one and a half to two days of backwash wastewater. The discharge enters a public storm sewer, then an unnamed tributary to the Pohatcong Creek. This action qualifies as a revision pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b)(1) which allows for the correction, clarification, or updating of erroneous, unclear, or outdated statements in Statewide and areawide WQM Plans.
