


REVISION TO THE UPPER RARITAN WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **FEB 01 1994**, pursuant to the provision of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:13-3.5, a revision to the Upper Raritan Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision acknowledges the existence of the Copper Hill Country Club (Block 84, Lots 14, 15, 33, 39 and 40) at the time of the Raritan Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) adoption on October 22, 1991, and identifies three treatment facilities (discharge to ground water) serving the Copper Hill Country Club Service Area. The facilities include: the system serving the clubhouse [New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit #NJ0074128 at 5,400 gallons per day (gpd)], limited by design to 4,600 gpd discharge; the system serving the office/house with a design flow of 350 gpd; and the system serving the pool/snack bar area with a discharge estimated to be less than 2,000 gpd. Block 84, Lots 39 and 40 are not included in Copper Hill Country Club's service area.
