


REVISION TO THE UPPER RARITAN WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on SEP 14 1994, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Raritan Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the WQMP to identify a total flow (maximum monthly average flow) of 21.3 million gallons per day (mgd) for the Somerset Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority (SRVSA) sewage treatment plant (STP) in Bridgewater Township, Somerset County. This facility discharges to Cuckels Brook (classified as FW-2 Nontrout waters), a tributary to the Raritan River. The WQMP is updated to specify the total flow of 21.3 mgd in recognition of the following: Consolidation of wastewater treatment facilities at the initial SRVSA STP with the wastewater treatment facilities previously owned and operated by American Cyanamid Company (currently Lederle Laboratories) for a total flow of 21.3 mgd. This revision does not negate any contractual agreements between SRVSA and Lederle Laboratories. Any proposed increase in the total flow to the SRVSA STP will require an amendment to the Upper Raritan WQMP.
