REVISION TO THE UPPER RARITAN WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Raritan Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision identifies the existing Tewksbury Township Elementary School (School) located on Block 16, Lot 6.03 in Tewksbury Township, Hunterdon County. This revision will modify the Upper Raritan WQMP and the Tewksbury Township Wastewater Management Plan to identify a portion of Block 16, Lot 6.03 as the Sewer Service Area (SSA) for the School. The School is located within the Highlands Preservation Area. As such, the SSA is limited to the existing building. The School is permitted under New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit # NJ0139998, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:9A-7.4, for 9,000 gallons per day to accommodate 600 students and faculty.

This action qualifies as a revision pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b) 1 which allows for revisions to correct, clarify, or update erroneous, unclear, or outdated statements in Statewide and areawide Water Quality Management Plans.
