Public Notice

Take notice that on April 19, 2022, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11-1 et seq., and the Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted an amendment to the Upper Raritan Water Quality Management (WQM) Plan. The amendment, identified as the Errico Acres, also known as Residences at Overleigh, (Program Interest No. 435434, Activity No. AMD200009) established a new sewer service area (SSA) within a portion of Block 5, Lot 4, Far Hills Borough, Somerset County to be served by a proposed New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) permitted discharge to groundwater (DGW) wastewater treatment facility.

A notice of the Adoption of this amendment was published in the New Jersey Register on May 16th, 2022, at 54 N.J.R. 917(a). Upon publication of the adoption notice, it was recognized there was a typographical error regarding the final projected flow. Due to this error, the projected
