## What is Fish & Wildlife (F&W)?

Fish & Wildlife protects animals and their homes so they can live well, also F&W manage hunting and fishing to keep animals safe.

F&W create places like parks and forests where people can enjoy nature and learn about wildlife.

You and your community can help by planting gardens for animals, keeping the environment clean, and using eco-friendly practices.

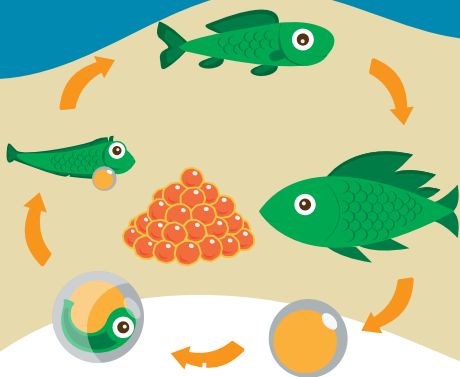


## Sedge Island

Sedge Island is a quiet spot where wildlife can live without much human interference.

The island has lots of different habitats, like salt marshes and shallow waters. These places are home to all kinds of plants and animals.

There are fun activities on Sedge Island, like bird watching, kayaking, and catching fish and crabs.



## Fisheries vs Hatcheries

Fisheries - Places where fish are caught or managed for things like food and fun.

Hatcheries - Fish nurseries. Once they're big enough, fish are released to help keep fish populations healthy.

Fish & Wildlife ensures people follow the rules about hunting, fishing, and protecting endangered animals. They aim to keep animals safe and prevent people from harming the environment by breaking the rules or laws.
