Historical Sites

There are over 50 NJ Historical sites which includes landmarks. buildings, & areas of significance. **Combining History with Environmental Science means** you can show how past environmental events shaped societies or help predict and protect the environment for the future.

Fire Prevention

NJ DEP Fire Prevention works to stop forest fires by educating people about fire safety rules and preventing careless behaviors like leaving campfires unattended. They also use tools like controlled burns to remove excess vegetation and reduce the risk of wildfires.

FREC

The Forest Resource Education Center teaches why NJ's parks, forests, and historical sites are important through activities and programs. It is important because it encourages outdoor fun while teaching visitors how to care for the environment. These activities help people learn about nature and how to protect it.
